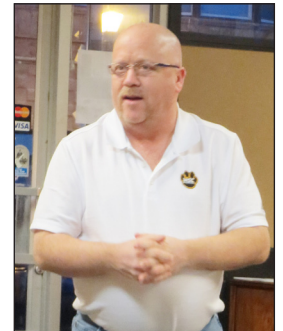

About Child Sexual Assault



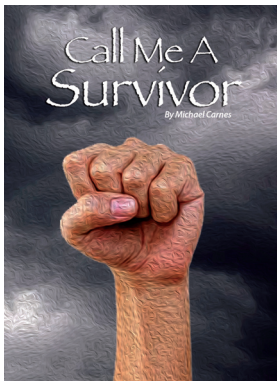
In the spring of 1976, the life of a 9-year-old boy in a small Nebraska town was forever altered when he was sexually assaulted by the older brother of a classmate. Although it was a one-time incident, the scars that remain haunted the young boy well into his adult years, driving him to the brink of suicide.

More than 35 years later, as one of the biggest stories in a generation rocked the college football world, that boy decided that NOW was the time to tell someone, anyone and everyone that he was a survivor – and that those who have lived through the torture of child sexual assault no longer need to think of themselves as victims.

Michael Carnes is an award-winning newspaper writer, editor and author of the book “Call Me A Survivor” who has deemed it his mission to tell his story and to encourage other survivors of sexual assault to look at themselves in a way they may not have considered – as a survivor, not a victim.

Carnes continues to research the topic and serve as an advocate for tougher legislation, and has a wealth of information and personal insight into the life of a child sexual assault survivor that he can bring to your community. He is engaging, unfiltered and open to bringing the topic out of the darkness and shed light on a subject that needs to be discussed in every community, large and small.

Carnes is educating the community and is an advocate for better education and stronger justice for survivors of child sexual assault. He will challenge your thinking and open your eyes to a world that no child should ever have to live in. You will be entertained and informed by his presentation, which can be adjusted to any age group.

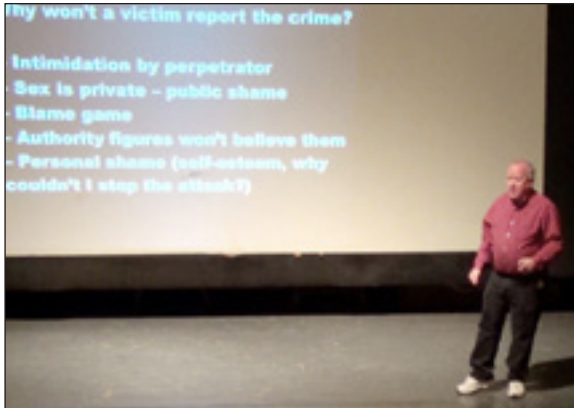

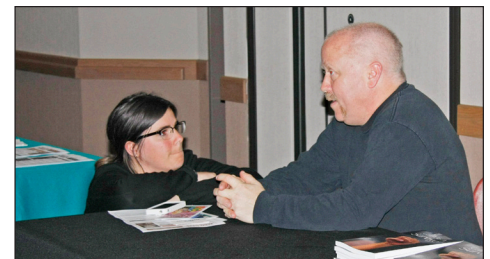
